The program offers comprehensive, personalized breast health services from routine screenings to complex diagnostic procedures and treatment evaluations. The center's state-of-the-art technologies include digital mammography, the ImageChecker™ computer-aided detection system, breast ultrasound, vacuum-assisted core breast biopsy with stereotactic or ultrasound guidance and MRI scans and MRI-guided breast biopsy.

Each week, a multidisciplinary team of health care specialists – the Sanofi-aventis U.S. Breast Cancer Institute - meets to discuss breast cancer patients diagnosed the previous week at the medical center, reviewing patient cases to ensure that the patient is offered the most appropriate treatment options. A breast cancer patient navigator helps coordinate patients' treatment plans in conjunction with the multidisciplinary team.
