The Breast Health Program (BHP) represents the best in diagnostic services, multidisciplinary care and an approach to breast health that focuses on empowering women with the best care, which is timely and compassionate. Our BHP sees women with a variety of breast concerns, some of which are: abnormal mammography, new breast mass, breast cancer risk assessment, a history of personal or family breast cancer. These women are introduced to our Breast Health Coordinator whose primary job is to advocate for her patient, provide her patient with the education that she needs, and ensure that she has immediate access to physicians as well as community resources that will enable the patient to address her health care needs. The BHP has a team of multidisciplinary health care providers whom meet and review breast cases prospectively. The team includes surgeons, radiologists, pathologists, medical oncologists, radiation oncologists, reconstructive plastic surgeons, nursing, genetics counseling, research assistants, social worker and the breast health coordinator. Together this team of trained professionals provides our breast patients and their families with support to battle breast disease, as well as the physical, emotional, and social effects they may experience. However, we think our patients actually provide the best feedback. Patient satisfaction levels are in the 95th percentile for the services rendered which reinforces our belief that superior care can be given close to home and in your own community.
